**Casas Patronales Carmenere** (Chile) 7.50 28  
 Red and violet in color. Full rich red fruit aromas of cherry jam, peppery and spicy with sweet green pepper notes. A velvety, well-balanced acidity with chocolate notes and sweet, round tannins.

**Stone Cellars by Beringer Cabernet Sauvignon** (Napa Valley, California) 7.00 26  
 Clean, round, mid-palate, showing blackberries and black currant.

**Alamos Malbec** (Mendoza, Argentina) 7.50 28  
 Deep violet in color with a beautiful nose of raspberries, plums, red currants, roasted nuts, vanilla and spice. - **W.E. 90**

## PINOT NOIR

**Hob Nob** (France) 8.00 30  
 Mixed berries, violets and vanilla on the nose.

**Erath** (Oregon) 39  
 Bright cherry and juicy red plum aromas are lifted by a hint of exotic, zesty spice. The sweet entry leads to mouth-filling cherry pie, red currant, and vanilla-coffee flavors that extend into a subtle smokiness and a long, luxurious finish.

## MERLOT

**Juniper Canyon** (California) 7.00 26  
 Packed with deep, dark berry fruit and nuanced hints of cocoa, herb and earth with a soft structure.

**Casa Lapostolle** (Chile) 46  
 Red fruit, sweet spices, touches of herb, white pepper with a well-integrated oak. - **Wine Enthusiast 88**

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

**Louis Martini** (Sonoma, California) 10.00 38  
 Offers many layers, featuring aromas and flavors of red cherry, blackberry and fresh sage. - **Wine Enthusiast 89**

**(BV) Beaulieu Vineyards** (Napa, California) 38  
 Aromas of black and green peppercorn with currant-mint and black tea overtones.

**Trapiche Broquel** (Mendoza, Argentina) 42  
 Aromas of cassis and raspberry jam, with an elegant touch of smoke, roasted red pepper and chocolate. - **WE 87**

**Kendall-Jackson "Grand Reserve"** (Sonoma, California) 54  
 Flavors of black currant, blackberry, blueberry and cassis with enticing aromas of mocha and nutmeg. Notes of smoke, cedar and tobacco leaf round out the lingering finish. - **Wine Advocate 93**

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

**Beringer "Knight's Valley"** (Sonoma, CA) 59  
 Firm, intense and concentrated with spicy, dried berry, sage and herbal scents. Full-bodied, ending with chewy tannins and a dash of black licorice. - **Wine Spectator 88**

**Trinchero "Chicken Ranch"** (Napa, California) 64  
 Bursts with Bing cherries, currants and cranberries. It is old world in style with its cigar box and savory aromas and structured tannins.

## OTHER REDS

**Uno Malbec** (Argentina) 10.00 38  
 Aromas of wild berry and dark plum with a hint of coffee.

**Alamos Malbec** (Mendoza, Argentina) 7.50 28  
 Beautiful nose of raspberries, plums, red currants, roasted nuts, vanilla and spice. - **W.E. 90**

**Volteo Tempranillo** (Spain) 8.00 30  
 The aroma of the wine leaves subtle memories of black currants and raspberries; on the palate it is fresh, structured and fruity.

**Scala Dei Negre Priorat** (Spain) 36  
 Rich, deep flavors of fig jam and blackberries.

**Campo Viejo Rioja "Gran Reserve"** (Spain) 48  
 Aroma of jam and wood, spicy tones. This is a wine with character and persistence.

**Four Vines "Old Vine Cuvee" Zinfandel** (California) 8.00 30  
 On the nose the wine has layers of berry fruit and anise aromas with hints of spice. On the palate, blackberry and spicy plum fruit with a rich mouth feel trailing to a velvety toasted oak finish.

**Michael David Gluttony Zinfandel** (Lodi, California) 95  
 Sweet briar fruit, bramble berry, raspberry, nutmeg and vanilla on the palate. Tannins are sweet with a lingering finish.

**Newton Claret Bordeaux Blend** (Napa, California) 59  
 Black cherry and currant supported by nutmeg and white pepper. Blueberry, black plum and cherry on the palate. - **Wine Spectator 88**

**Lindemans Reserve Shiraz** (Australia) 7.50 28  
 Ripe dark fruits, coffee / mocha oak complexity.

**Penfolds Kalimna Bin 28 Shiraz** (Australia) 54  
 Spiced, dark licorice and chocolate with cranberry acidity on the finish. - **Wine Spectator 90**

**Tenuta di Arceno Chianti Classico** (Italy) 10.00 38  
 Hint of resinous forest quality with aromas of cherry and spice.

**Monsanto Chianti Classico** (Italy) 46  
 Black cherries, herbs, tobacco and spices come together in a dark, brooding expression of Sangiovese. - **Robert Parker, Wine Advocate 91**



## FEATURED WHITES

**Citra Pinot Grigio** (Sicilia, Italy) 7.00 26  
Delicate and pleasing with fresh floral fruit notes.

**(BV) Beaulieu Vineyards Sauvignon Blanc** (Napa Valley, California) 7.50 28  
Fruity aromas with notes of pineapple, freshly cut grass and hints of lemon. - **A Wine Enthusiast Best Buy**

**Loredona Riesling** (Monterey, California) 8.00 30  
Delicate yet persistent aromas of lychee, citrus blossoms and a touch of honey. The crisp, refreshing palate offers layers of white peach, honeydew melon and lemon-lime.

## CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

**Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin** (France) 89  
Full-bodied, packed with ripe, creamy fruit aromas.

**Moët & Chandon Imperial** (France) 79  
Aroma is radiant, revealing bright yellow-fleshed fruits (apple, pear, yellow peach), honey, floral nuances and elegant notes of brioche and fresh nuts.

**Freixenet Brut Classic** (Spain) 32  
A cava with an exceptional fresh, fruity style and a lingering aroma.

**Avissi Prosecco** (Italy) 31  
Inviting fresh fruit flavors lead to a clean crispness on the palate and refined finish.

**Zonin Prosecco** split 8.00  
Very well-balanced and appealing, with an extremely delicate almond note.

## CHARDONNAY

**Entwine by Wente** (California) 9.00 34  
Easy-drinking, with crisp fall fruit – think toast spread with homemade apple butter.

**Dynamite** (Sonoma, California) 7.00 26  
The very aromatic nose carries notes of pineapple and a touch of vanilla from the oak, and the palate is softer and richer with a long and very full-flavored finish. - **Wine Spectator 87**

**Kendall Jackson "Avant"** (Sonoma, California) 10.00 38  
Vivid, crisp and bright, with layers of fresh pineapple, bright green apple, crisp Meyer lemon, juicy pear and wildflowers. Refreshing acidity and sleek mineral noted are balanced by a rounded mid-palate and slight oakiness with a long, pure fruit finish. - **Robert Parker 88 & Wine Enthusiast 90**

**Sonoma Cutrer "Russian River"** 375ml 22  
(Sonoma, California)  
Floral aromas of lavender, honey and honeysuckle give way to white peach and tropical aromas of mango and pineapple. Citrus flavors of lemon pie filling and lime are complimented by fuji apple, pear and white cherries. A touch of caramel leads to an amazingly long, lemon Jolly Rancher finish for a very refreshing wine.

## PINOT GRIGIO

**Citra** (Sicilia, Italy) 7.00 24  
Delicate and pleasing with fresh floral and fruit notes.

**Santa Margherita "Alto Adige"** (Italy) 49  
The clean, intense aroma and dry flavor with pleasant green apple aftertaste make Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio a wine of character and versatility. - **Wine Spectator 88**

## OTHER WHITES

**Murphy Goode Fume Blanc** 8.50 32  
(Sonoma, California)  
Fermented in stainless steel to retain the citrus and tropical fruit aromatics while the balance was barrel fermented in French and American oak to increase the mouthfeel and develop flavors of white peach and honeydew melon. - **Wine Advocate 90**

**Spy Valley Sauvignon Blanc** (New Zealand) 39  
Juicy and lithe, the palate is alive with refreshing ripe fruits and has a rich, lingering finish. - **Wine Spectator 89**

**Kim Crawford Sauvignon Blanc** (New Zealand) 39  
Elegant and vibrant, this mouthwatering wine offers lime and tequila flavors that are reminiscent of a margarita, but remains light, refined and distinctive. - **Wine Spectator 89**

**Pierre Sparr Pinot Blanc** (Alsace, France) 8.50 32  
An easy going thirst quenching wine that reveals flavors of pear, lemon, melon and a hint of minerals. Concentrated, dry, with a fresh citric acidity which balances addictively with all this fruit.
